The paintings of Frank Licsko are something to behold. Cherished for their brilliance and intensity, his works have been recognized by private and corporate art collectors for some four decades as unrivaled.

Among the hundreds of collectors of Licsko originals are the late Hubert Humphrey, Vice-President of the United States, the Emperor of Japan, (His Excellency) Zediad Shawwaf, Ambassador of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and the National Gallery of Canada. Recent collectors include actor Clint Eastwood through his Tehama luxury estate development company, actor Larry Hagman (J.R. Ewing of Dallas), Dr. Laura Schlessinger (national radio talk show host), and the President of Technicolor.

Already reknowned as a child prodigy, at fourteen Licsko was entered into an international art competition with over 4,000 entrants. He won first place. Early on, his work was most influenced by Da Vinci, Michaelangelo, Kriegoff, and Dali. Over time, his work became recognized as powerful and important expressions of art.

Residing in the Paso Robles wine country on the central coast of California has further served to intensify his work and inspire the art that could only be described as a Licsko.
